CONDITIONS: Non Professional Riders Only. All riders in flat races to be 15 years and over. Riders under 10 years must choose either under 10 led or under 14 ridden events and stay in that group unless otherwise stated on the programme. Approved helmets to be worn in all events. Novelty events run under Committee Rules based on A.N.R.A. Rules. Copies available at Secretary's Office. Minimum weight for all flat races 63.5kg., except Jumbo, live weight 73 kg., race weight minimum 83kg. Judges decision is final. All riders to be approved by the Committee. The Committee reserves the right to alter or delete any part of the programme. The Committee has the right to remove or order from the grounds any person or horse acting in a dangerous or uncontrollable manner as to cause embarrassment or injury to others. No rider to partake of **intoxicating drink** before last race. Competitors in flat races to wear Colours, some Club Colours available.

NO DOGS ALLOWED.

\* The committee advises that we will run our event with added novelties if we are unable to have horse events.

## **Safety Policy and Procedures**

### **Policy**

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*The safety of all persons either active in conducting the annual event, competing or spectating is of the utmost importance. The club will make resources available and minimise risks to ensure the event is run safely.*

### **Safety Responsibilities**

- Promoting and maintaining safety is primarily the responsibility of the Committee.
- All committee members are required to follow the Safety Policy and procedures to insure their health and safety and the health and safety of others.
- Competitors and members of the general public are reminded of their common law duty not to cause harm to others either wilfully or negligently.
- Competitors will be reminded of their safety responsibilities when nominating.
- All patrons will be informed when first entering the racecourse of the Safety Policy and informed of their obligations. Public announcements through out the day will remind visitors of their safety obligations.
- Patrons are asked to bring to the attention of the committee any concerns relating to safety or any potential safety issues.

### **Implementing the policy**

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The Club will implement the Safety Policy by adopting The Australian Quarter Horse Association Risk Audit for Event Management:

1. Develop and implement a Hazard and Risk Management Plan.
2. Promote, maintain and improve safety procedures.
3. Follow the 5-step risk management approach to hazards in the workplace
  - See the hazard (Identify)
  - Assess the risk
  - Fix It (Control)
  - Evaluate the Control (Review)
  - Record it

In order to implement the general provisions of this policy, a program of activities and procedures will be set up, continually updated, and effectively carried out:

- Emergency procedures
- Event site inspections and evaluations
- Reporting and recording of incidents, accidents, injuries and illnesses
- Development of an ongoing consultation plan.

This Policy will come in to effect from 1<sup>st</sup> August 2007 and will be reviewed subject to discussion and agreement of the committee.
