Novelty events run under Committee Rules based on A.N.R.A. Rules. Copies available at Secretary's Office. Minimum weight for all flat races 63.5kg., except Jumbo, live weight 73 kg., race weight minimum 83kg. Judges decision is final. All riders to be approved by the Committee. The Committee reserves the right to alter or delete any part of the programme. The Committee has the right to remove or order from the grounds any person or horse acting in a dangerous or uncontrollable manner as to cause embarrassment or injury to others.
